Course includes: Externship placement to one of our contracted providers: **Paramedics Plus, Royal Ambulance, Westmed Ambulance, Pro-Transport, and Norcal Ambulance**, National Registry skills testing, and a BLS course.

Students must purchase course text book and workbook, Brady Emergency Care 13th Edition, prior to class approximate fee \$170. You will be given instructions on how to purchase upon registration.

Pre-requisites: High School Diploma or equivalent, Valid Identification Card. Proof of immunizations must be provided during course with a copy of your healthcare card.

Students must clear a background check, approximate fee \$75 and clean drug test, approximate fee \$65. A contracted vendor will perform service during course.
