Emergency Medical Technician

The following objectives have been established for the Emergency Medical Technician program based upon California EMS Authority and the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians. They adhere to the Department of Transportation's National Standard Training Curricula:

- Develop the EMT-B student to understand the career field of Emergency Medical Systems and the roles and responsibilities of the EMT-B in the EMS field.
- Provide the EMT-B student the knowledge, skills, and ability to provide top-level care while functioning safely and effectively in the pre-hospital environment.
- Ensure the EMT-B student demonstrates competency and proficiency in basic EMT skills with each patient he/she encounters.
- Prepare the EMT-B student to successfully complete the National Registry Licensure Examination.

Monitor Technician

- Equip students with the knowledge, skills, and competencies to successfully complete the Monitor Technician training program.
- Prepare students for the responsibilities of providing quality patient care as a Monitor Technician.

Continuing education & career advancement:
