We appreciate you choosing **American Health Education** for your EMT, Fire, and American Heart Association trainings. We want you to know that your safety is our top priority as we continue providing educational opportunities during the pandemic. Here's a look at the precautions we've put in place:

For all our students:

- Temperature screening and daily COVID questionnaire required before entering building.
- Socially-distant classroom set-up.
- Plexiglass dividers.
- Classrooms disinfected from top to bottom with bleach disinfectant wipes 3 times per day.
- Hand sanitizer in every classroom and lobby.
- Gloves available at all times, in every room.
- Air purifiers in every room.
- Staggered report times to limit gathering around building entry.

For EMT students:

- Online tests.
- Zoom lectures.
- Classes separated into 3 groups, max of 10 students, to limit exposure.
- Skills practice outside when possible.
- N95 student fit testing and issuance.
- Student safety officers assigned.
